YOU WILL NEED:

1. Internet access, and a laptop, tablet, or phone. (The largest screen is best.)
2. A way to print out or view the reference photo. (For best printing results, use photo paper.)
3. You may print out the pattern on drawing paper.
4. Drawing paper (The project is 5" x 7", but leave a 1/2" border and more room for color swatches).
5. Pencil and Pen

7. Pencil Sharpener
8. White eraser

Before the day of the workshop:

1. Gather your supplies. You'll need drawing paper, tracing paper, transfer paper (optional), a pencil and pen, colored pencils*, pencil sharpener, and masking tape or painter's tape. (See supply list)
2. Print out the reference photo. The photo is attached to this email as a jpeg file, and will print out best in color on photo paper, if you have it. If you don't have photo paper or a color printer, you can have the image printed at places like Office Depot, CVS, etc. The size of the photo image should be approximately 5" x 7"

On the day of the workshop:

You will need this link to join the meeting. Please get online about 10 minutes before the start of the workshop. Click on the link and it will take you to the meeting.
